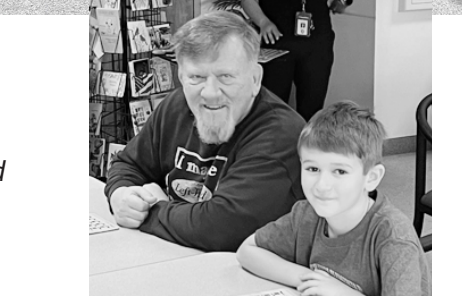

Summer Crisis Program Starts July 1st



The Ohio Department of Development’s HEAP Summer Crisis Program will begin July 1, 2026. Geauga County Residents may apply through Lifeline. The Home Energy Assistance Program Summer Crisis Program helps income eligible Ohioans stay cool during the hot summer months. The program runs from July 1 – September 30, 2026.

For information about the program guidelines or to apply for the program, clients are required to schedule a telephone interview with Lifeline. Appointments can be scheduled by calling 440-354-2148.

Applicants will need to provide copies of the following documents to complete the application:

- Proof of income for each household member. Income includes: Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Income (SSDI), Social Security, Pension, Alimony, Wages, Self-employment, Unemployment, etc.
- Copies of your most recent utility bills.
- A list of all household members, including Social Security numbers and birth dates.
- Proof of U.S. citizenship/legal residency for all household members. Documents that are accepted to prove U.S. citizenship/legal residency include: a Social Security Card, birth certificate, U.S. Passport, naturalization paper/certification of citizenship, permanent VISA, or INS ID Card.
- If renting, copy of current rental lease or if client owns their home, copy of current property taxes.

The Summer Crisis Program assists low-income households with a household member 60 or older, households with an electric disconnect notice, disconnected service, or need to establish new service, or households with a household member with a medical condition that requires air conditioning. Households enrolled in the Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP) may also be eligible for assistance. Household income must be at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Households may receive a payment up to \$500 on their electric bill. Other benefits may include central air conditioning repair, air conditioner window units and fans for eligible households.

Do you Qualify for Assistance with Your Medical Bills or Prescription Medicines?

If you meet the 2026 income guidelines below, contact a Geauga Department on Aging social worker at 440-279-2130 for assistance with your application!

Medicare Savings Programs (MSPs) and Extra Help

Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB): Pays for Part A & B deductibles, coinsurance/copays and premiums.

Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB): Pays for monthly Part B premium.

Qualified Individual (QI): Pays for monthly Part B premium (limited benefits)

Qualified Disabled & Working Individuals (QDWI): Pays for Part A premium if you are under 65, disabled and no longer entitled to free Part A because you work.

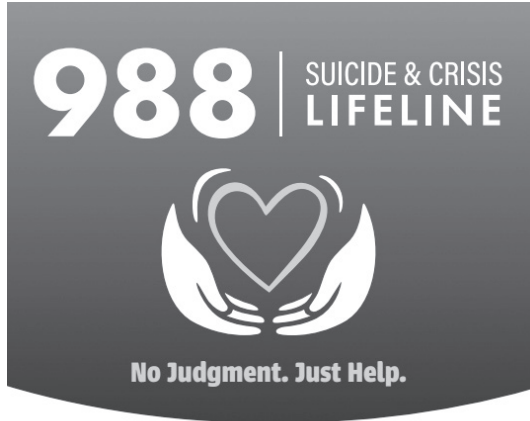
Refund Policy for the Geauga Department on Aging
